MINUTES TOWN COUNCIL TOWN OF SHENANDOAH PUBLIC HEARING FISCAL YEAR 2020/2021 BUDGET AMENDMENT

JUNE 22, 2021

The Shenandoah Town Council held a public hearing on Tuesday, June 22, 2021, beginning at 7:00 p.m., with Mayor Clinton O. Lucas, Jr., presiding.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.
